Terms & Conditions

1. Eligibility

- Volunteers must be at least 18 years old to travel independently. Volunteers under 15 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

- Health and Fitness: Participants should be in good physical health, as the program includes manual labor.

- Visa and Travel Requirements: Volunteers are responsible for ensuring they meet the visa and entry requirements for Zanzibar. Applicants who have paid for visa services will have their applications managed by the Parallel Gives Program.

2. Payments & (Payment Gatway Fees + Cancellation Policy):

Full Payment: The full balance is due before the program start date.

Payment Gatways fees + 90% refund for cancellations made more than one week before the start date.

Payment Gatways fees + 50% refund for cancellations made less than one week before the start date.
